

Instructions:

In order to install I Can Animate over a network you need to following these procedures. This documentation will be enhanced and more complete in due course, in the meantime this should get most network administrators up and working.

You must use the 'network version' of the I Can Animate MSI. This MSI simply installs the application files, two shortcuts into the Start menu and writes the registration information into the appropriate keys in the registry. You will need to ensure that you have previously installed the Microsoft .NET 3 framework to each client machine. If you wish to export movies as either QuickTime or WMV then you must also ensure that the machines have QuickTime for Windows version 7.5 or higher installed and the Windows media encoder respectively for each movie format. I Can Animate will simply 'grey out' these options if the appropriate component is missing.

In order for the registration information to be written to the registry will need to generate an MST using the supplied application. This is a 'transform' file which needs to be applied to the I Can Animate MSI.

The ICANetworkReg.exe is the application that is needed to created the transform file. It needs to be run from the same folder as the I Can Animate.msi The application is self explanatory. You need to enter the user name, establishment and serial number into the three text fields. You must enter the serial number exactly as it is provided on your registration card. Please ensure each group of four numbers is separated with a dash - and with no spaces. The application does not check the validity of the serial number. Click the Generate MST button and enter a file name for the MST file. Save this file to an appropriate location on your server. This MST needs to be applied to the I Can Animate MSI.
