



# Kudlian iMovie Plug-ins Mac OS X 10.5 Leopard

## Plug-ins do not appear in iMovie HD on Leopard or after installing iLife '08

The plug-ins work on Mac OS X Leopard but unless our guidelines are followed, you will encounter problems. You will need to download and install iMovie HD.

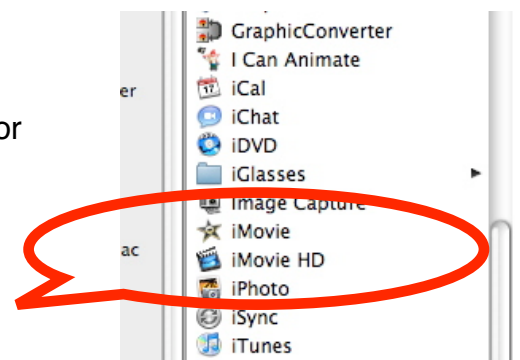

If you have failed to follow these guidelines you will find that the 'plug-ins' do not appear in the 'Video FX' list in iMovie HD's 'Editing' option.

If this is the case you will need to do the following:

- You need to be logged onto the computer with administrator access rights.
- Make sure that iMovie HD has been installed to the computer and that the application itself resides in the root of the Applications folder. It should appear similar to the picture opposite. If iMovie HD is not located in this position then the plug-in will not install correctly.



If you have already attempted to install the plug-in(s) then you will need to remove the installation packages for each of them.

- Open the finder and locate the Receipts folder

`/Library/Receipts/`

- This can be found by selecting the hard disk icon and then opening the Library folder.
- The Receipts folder contains .pkg (install packages) for;

iMovieChartingPlugin for iLife '05.pkg

iMoviePicturePlugin for iLife '05.pkg

iMovieWeatherPlugin for iLife '05.pkg

One for each of the Plug-ins you have installed.

- Each package needs to be deleted, by moving it to the *Trash* and then emptying it.
- Next
- insert the CD containing the plug-in you wish to install and run the installer again.
- We would also recommend that when you have finished reinstalling that you run Apple's *Disk Utility* and choose to *Repair Permissions* on your hard disc.
- The plug-ins will now work correctly.
